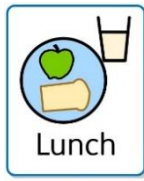
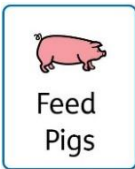
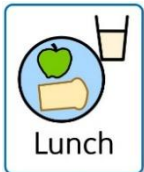


EXAMPLE 1 NIGHT SLEEPOVER
